Horse owners, farriers, trimmers and veterinarians are encouraged to attend. Space is limited to 12 participants for the trimming portion of the clinic. Registration is offered at a *one-time discount* of \$175 per participant (normally \$275) for both days. Registration for only the lecture portion of the clinic (Saturday) is \$75. You may bring your horse for the trimming portion of the clinic on Sunday. Stall board is available for \$10/night.

Keith Seeley is a graduate of Casey and Son Horseshoeing School, a Certified Journeyman II farrier, and a lifetime member and past board member of eight years for the B.W.F.A. Keith has been specializing in lameness cases for over 20 years.
